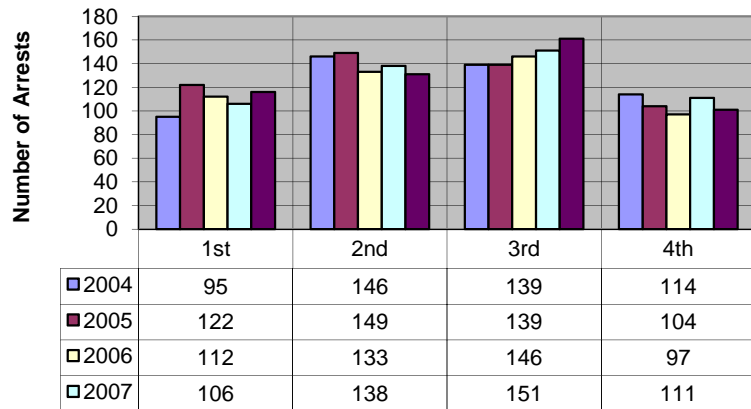

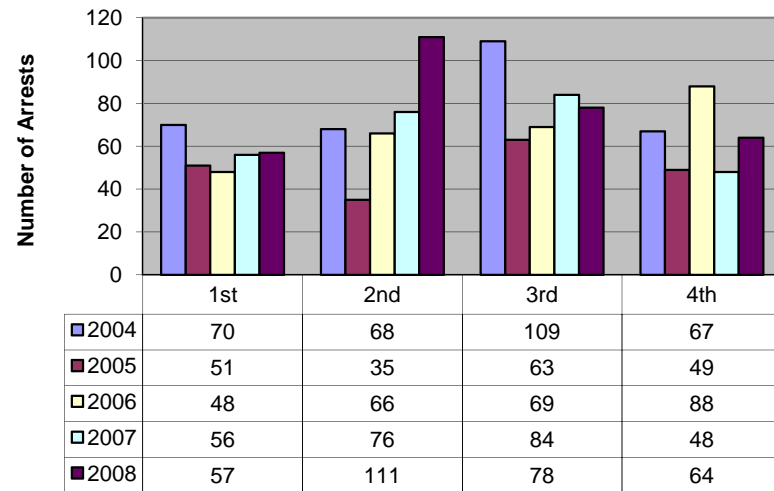

Graphic Analysis by Quarter and Year

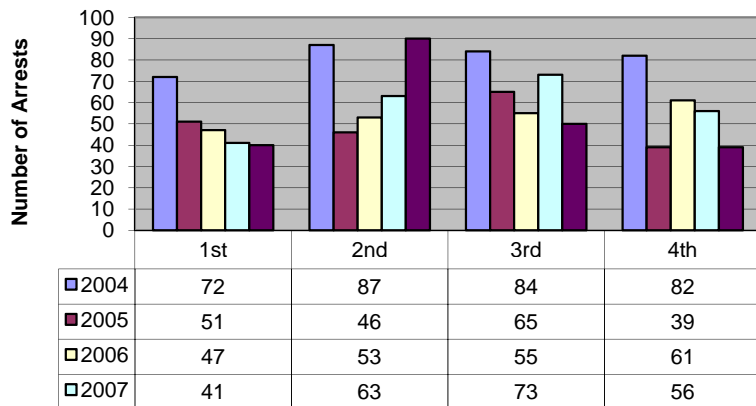

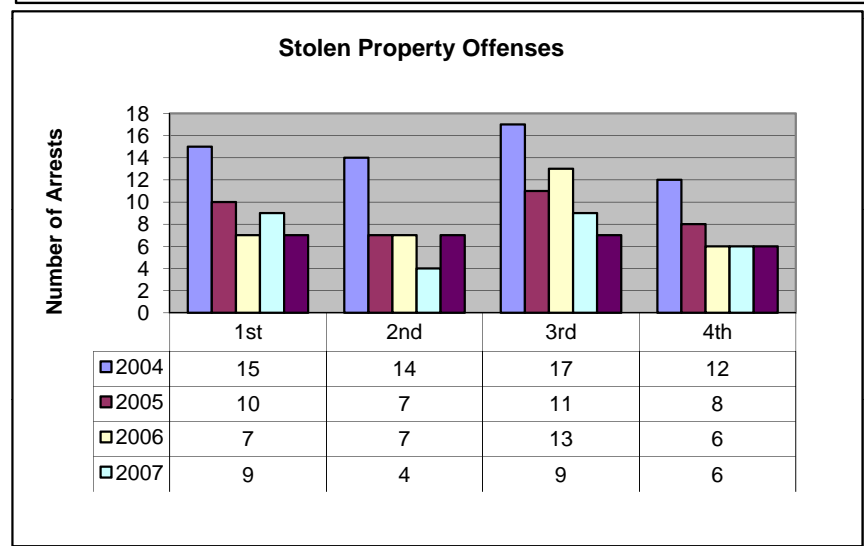
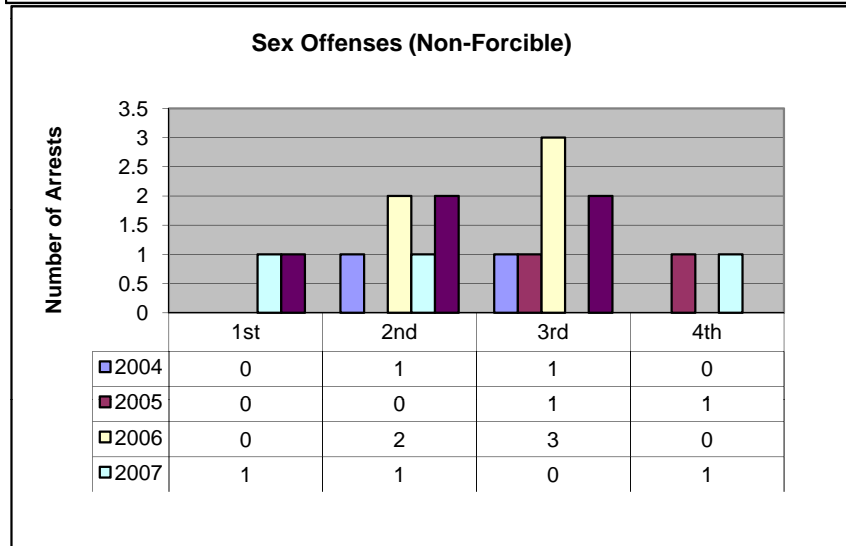
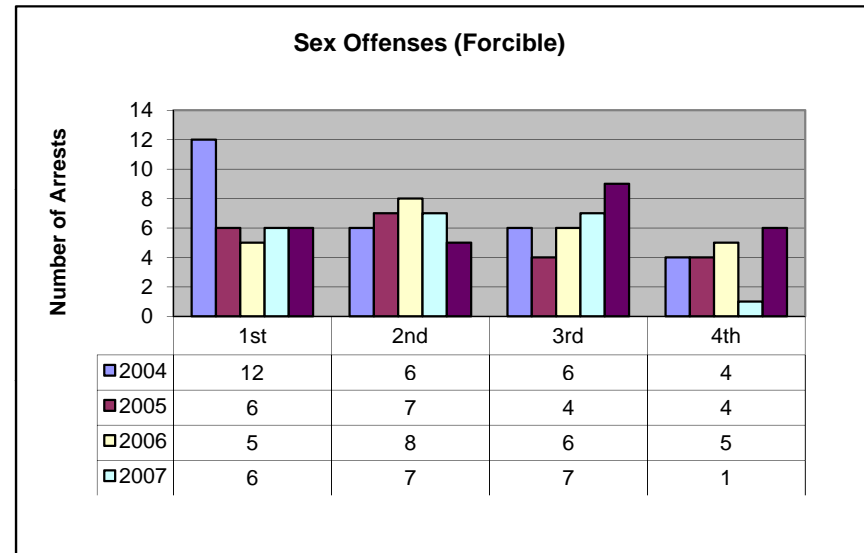
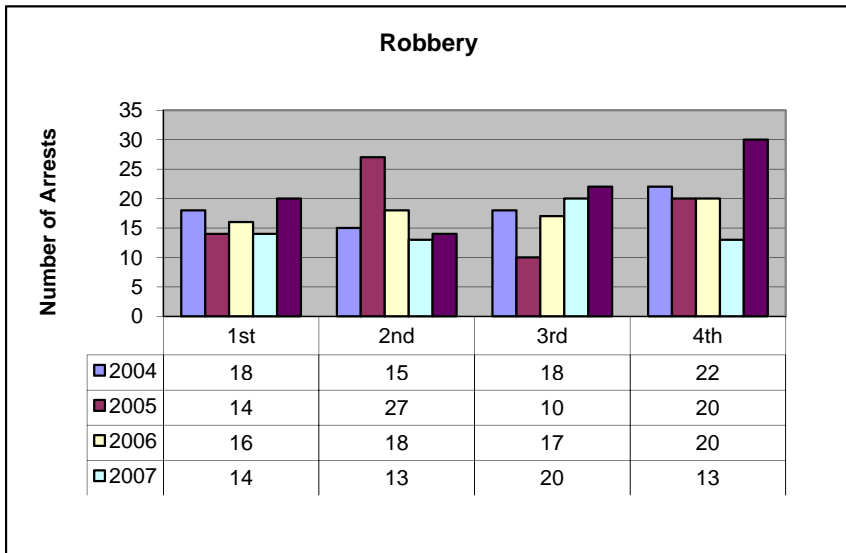
Graphic Analysis by Quarter and Year
